



## MANITOBA GOLF HALL OF FAME

### NOMINATION FORM

The Manitoba Golf Hall of Fame is dedicated to the recognition of extraordinary contributions and accomplishments in the game of golf in the Province of Manitoba. Honoured members, which include amateur and professional golfers (both male and female) and builders of the sport have been inducted on a regular basis since in 2003.

The Manitoba Golf Hall of Fame Selection Committee is responsible for reviewing nominations and selecting inductees. The Selection Committee is comprised of representatives of Golf Manitoba; the PGA of Manitoba; the Manitoba Golf Superintendents Association and other individuals interested in preserving the history and tradition of the game in Manitoba.

Once elected to the Hall of Fame, the Honoured Member is officially inducted at a special ceremony hosted by the Manitoba Golf Hall of Fame and Museum Inc. The Honoured Member's official plaque is then enshrined in the Hall of Fame.

To be considered for election to the Hall of Fame, the nominee must have made an extraordinary provincial, national, or international contribution to the game of golf in Manitoba. These achievements may be in the form of golfing accomplishments, an illustrious golf-related career, or some other exceptional contribution to the sport. Nominees may be players, course designers/managers, administrators, and others.

Nominations must have the consent of the nominee or, if the nominee is deceased, the immediate family. Every nomination must be seconded. Individuals may not nominate themselves. Nominations must be made on the attached forms and, together with any supporting documentation, **submitted by April 30<sup>th</sup>** to:
